

Search Notes for Federal Civil War Burial Sheets Database

The records reflected in the accompanying database are transcriptions of the original burial records microfilmed by the National Archives. Entries were transcribed as accurately and thoroughly as possible, including handwritten changes to names and other information. All columns in the original ledger book were included in the transcription. Names were cross-checked with those listed in the Roll of Honor to help verify identity and names were also checked by a supervisor to ensure accuracy.

Please keep the following in mind when searching the data:

- The data is searchable by keyword across the following fields:
 - Name (*name of interred*)
 - Rank
 - Company
 - Regiment
 - Date of Death
 - Epitaphs, Remarks, Etc.
 - National Cemetery Section
 - Description of Locality (*original burial place*)
- Crossed-out text is noted as such.
- Capitalization, punctuation and spelling were kept as found in the original ledger.
